Pool Passes & Guests

• Owners & Residents entering the pool area must show a valid pool pass and sign in.

- All guests must be accompanied by an Owner/Resident.
- Guest Passes can be purchased in advance or charged to your unit upon entering the pool.

Health & Safety

• All persons using the pool or grounds do so at their own risk.

• Any injuries must be reported to the lifeguard, council member or property manager immediately. If emergency services are required, any fees incurred will be the responsibility of the individual. Owners/Residents are responsible for themselves, their children and guests.

• Appropriate attire must be worn when swimming or sunbathing.

• Persons with communicable or contagious illnesses, skin conditions, infections, etc. are not permitted to use the pool. During inclement weather or any conditions hazardous to swimmers, the lifeguard is authorized to close the pool.

• Proper respect and cooperation are due to the lifeguards or council member who are there to provide for the safe and orderly operation of the pool. Unnecessary distraction of the lifeguard is prohibited while she/he is on duty.

• No throwing or tossing children into the air or to one another due to the possibility of injuries.

• Jumping, diving, dunking, throwing, pushing, running or other horseplay, etc. are strictly prohibited in the pool area.

• Water guns, pool toys, large flotation devices, etc. may be used at the discretion of the lifeguard and/or management. No glass *or* other breakable containers or other hazardous items are allowed in the pool area. Absolutely **no alcohol or illegal substances** are permitted in the pool area at any time.

General

• Repair and replacement costs for any damaged pool property will be charged to the appropriate owner/resident. Please be considerate while in the pool area; keep the area clean and throw any trash in the cans provided.

• Anyone leaving the pool area for more than 30 minutes must remove his or her towel & belongings from the chair.

• No smoking inside the pool fence or within 25 feet of the pool entrance gates. Butts must be placed in approved containers.

• No pets, profanity, obscene gestures, loud or offensive music, skateboarding, rollerblading, bikes, etc. allowed.

• All children 16 years of age and younger must be always accompanied by an adult 18 years or older.

• Adults are responsible for the actions and safety of their children. In order for a child to be permitted to attend the pool alone, she/he must be at least 16 years old, able to swim, and provide parent's written permission.

•Children who are not trained in the toilet must always wear a waterproof diaper or waterproof pull-up in the pool.

• Children requiring flotation devices are required to be accompanied by a parent/guardian while in the pool and **MUST** remain in the shallow end before the rope.

• The lifeguard staff reserves the right to dismiss anyone from the pool area who violates these rules.

• Any decision of the lifeguard, council members or management are final!
